## Morning Courses (Monday through Thursday):

- ☆ **English Writing Intensive:** Students will write, receive feedback, and do re-writes each week. Writing topics for older children will include literature, science, and technology. Writing topics for younger children will include rules for good English, toys, and games.
- ☆ **Super Math:** Super-Math includes word problems, math puzzles, and math games that don't fit into the regular school year. The twin goals: make math easier, make math fun!
- ☆ **LMS Experience:** A set of unique academic programs for children Kindergarten through 6th grade. It works outside of the school system to help round out your child's education, and includes Chinese lessons.

## Weekly Afternoon Theme:

- ☆ **Classic Chinese Toys (6/9 – 6/13):** Join us for a fun-filled summer adventure exploring traditional Chinese toys and games! At our Traditional Chinese Children's Toys Summer Camp, kids will experience the joy of classic games while developing skills in coordination, strategy, and teamwork. This immersive cultural experience allows children to learn, play, and make new friends while discovering the magic of traditional Chinese toys, like Chinese Yo-Yo (Diabolo), Spinning Top, Marble Games, Chinese Jump Rope, Chinese Chess (Xiangqi), and Gomoku.
- ☆ **Exploring the Fantasy Story (6/16 – 6/20):** Fantasy stories are uniquely good at capturing the attention of imagination-starved students. Participants will experience fantasy in the written word, in video, and in a role-playing game.
- ☆ **Boardgame Adventures (6/23 – 6/27):** Boardgames are great for developing logical thinking skills. Even the youngest students can learn to play the simpler games.
- ☆ **Fun Science (7/14 – 7/18):** This camp is designed to develop a love for science in young children, and introduce them to various scientific concepts in a fun and exciting way. The experiments include color and crystals science, butter slime, fragrant mini soaps, magic balloon, water fireworks, glowing night lamp, etc.
- ☆ **Claymation (7/21 – 7/25):** Claymation is an animation technique using movable clay characters and stop-motion recording. It's a film style often seen in cartoons. Students will experience a meticulous process of creating their own stories, characters, and background props, and shoot their own films. Students are encouraged to bring their own iPads.
- ☆ **DIY Decorative Art (7/28 – 8/1):** Practice in creating visually appealing, small decorative objects, focusing on aesthetics and function, and utilizing a wide range of materials. Lovely yarn animals with frames, colorful foam sponge landscapes, inspirational rock paintings, well displayed with adorable picture stands. Learning painting methods and craft-making tips, exploring ideas of 3-D designs, color matching skills, playing games like stone mazes.
- ☆ **Coding 101 (8/4 – 8/8):** Coding 101 is a program designed to introduce young children to the fundamental concepts of computer programming through hands-on projects, typically using a visual, beginner-friendly language like Scratch, to build their interactive creations like animations and games while developing logical thinking and problem-solving skills in a setting focused on exploration and creativity.
